AU CDC MECHANISMS



1. **Rumor tracking system**
2. **Vaccine Perception Survey**
 - South Africa, DRC, Gabon, Côte d'Ivoire, Nigeria - surveyed over 4 weeks
3. **Vaccine Development and Access Strategy**
 - Objectives: African involvement in trials, access to vaccine, remove barriers to delivery
4. **Africa Task Force for Coronavirus (AFTCOR)**
 - Promote coordination of data collection and sharing. Has 6 working groups
5. **Risk Communication and Community Engagement Working Group**
6. **Vaccine Acceptability Campaign: M&C Saatchi - Pilot in DRC, Nigeria and South Africa**
